## WHY THIS INFORMATION

Pursuant to Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (hereinafter the "Regulation"), this page describes how we process the personal data of users consulting our website.

## DATA CONTROLLER

## LEGAL BASIS OF THE PROCESSING

The personal data indicated on this page are processed by our Company in order to promote our products and to protect us from possible computer attacks on the basis of the legitimate interest in pursuing the corporate purpose and protecting our assets.

## TYPES OF DATA PROCESSED AND PURPOSES OF PROCESSING

### Browsing data

The computer systems and software procedures used to operate this site acquire, during their normal operation, some personal data whose transmission is implicit in the use of Internet communication protocols.

This category of data includes the IP addresses or domain names of the computers and terminals used by users, the URI/URL (Uniform Resource Identifier/Locator) notation addresses of the resources requested, the time of the request, the method used to submit the request to the server, the size of the file obtained in response, the numerical code indicating the status of the response given by the server (successful, error, etc.) and other parameters relating to the user's operating system and IT environment.

These data, necessary for the use of web services, are also processed in order to

- obtain statistical information on the use of the services (most visited pages, number of visitors per time slot or per day, geographical areas of origin, etc.)
- checking the correct functioning of the services offered.

Browsing data do not persist for more than seven days (except in the event of the need to ascertain crimes by the judicial authorities).

## Data communicated by the user

The optional, explicit and voluntary sending of messages to the contact addresses of our Company entails the acquisition of the sender's contact data, necessary to reply, as well as all the personal data included in the communications.

## Cookies and other tracking systems

Cookies are not used for user profiling.

Use is made of technical session cookies (not persistent), strictly limited to what is necessary for the safe and efficient navigation of the site. (language management)

## RECIPIENTS OF DATA

The recipients of the data collected following consultation of some of the services listed above are the following parties designated by our Company, pursuant to Article 28 of the Regulation, as data processors, who may designate sub-processors for the purposes specified herein in compliance with the provisions of Article 28 of the RGPD

- IT and hosting companies functional to the operation and maintenance of the website and e-mail server.

## RIGHTS OF DATA SUBJECTS
